



## **Band 7 Trainee Advanced Practitioners**

An exciting opportunity has arisen for enthusiastic and ambitious registered staff to train to become an Advanced Practitioner and join our existing team to assist in providing primary care in General practice and multidisciplinary care in our exiting Integrated Care Organisation employed by Salford Primary Care Together.

You will need to have high level of experience in a band 6 role or above and have sound clinical knowledge whilst also demonstrating managerial, leadership and academic abilities. The successful candidates will be supported to complete an MSc in Advanced Clinical Practice (Advanced Practitioner) with the support and guidance of our medical colleagues and with mentorship from an experienced Advanced Practitioner.

Salford has an excellent reputation in training and developing its senior workforce and this post is a new role to support our constantly changing face of primary care as we adapt to new, exciting and evolving patient needs.

During the training period you will have a role in providing care to Salford registered patients utilizing and developing the newly acquired skills from the Masters programme. You will spend time in both General Practice and community settings, seeing and treating a wide range of presentations, for example: Core general practice, MDT teams, GP streaming within A/E, care of the elderly and other vulnerable groups.
